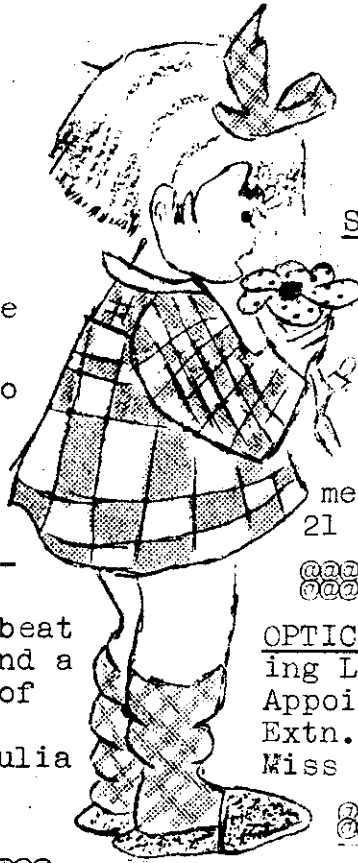

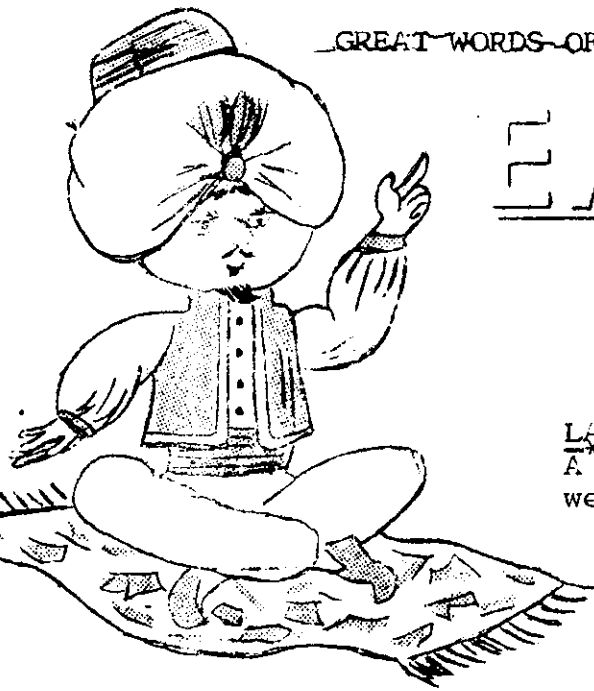

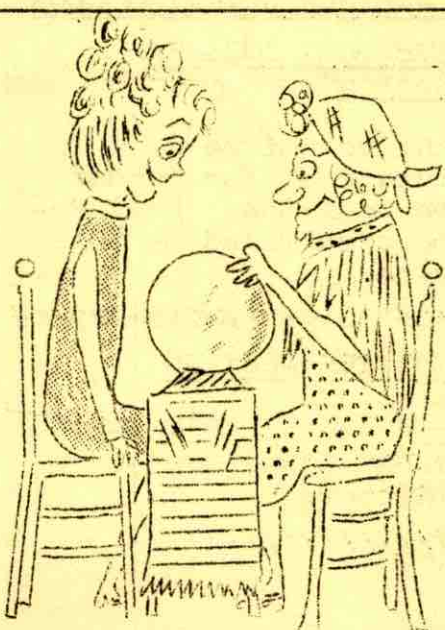
On Sunday 9 September 1973, our express coach became fully loaded and we were unable to carry all people requiring passage to Adelaide from northern areas.



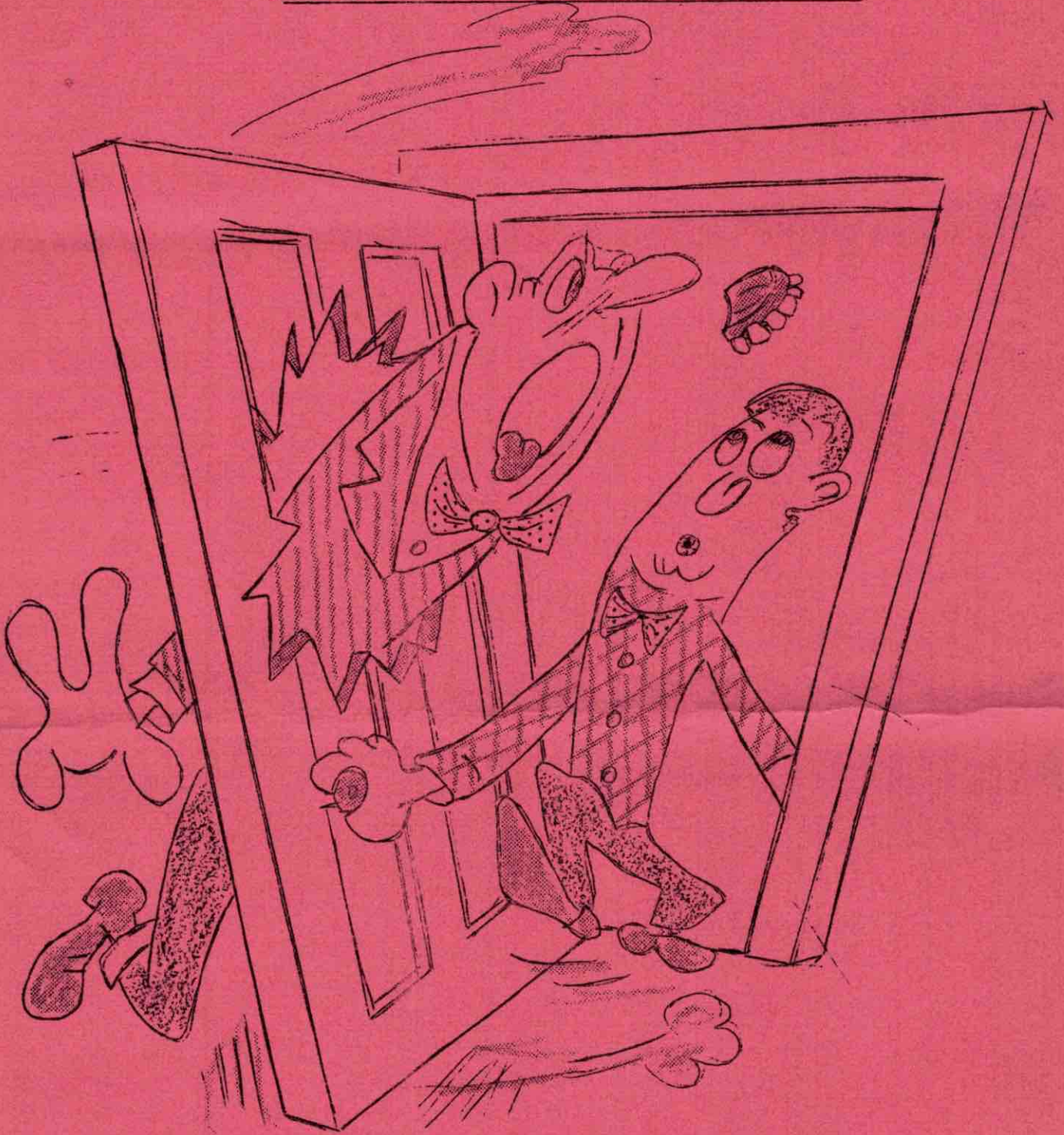
