





#### FEDERAL MEMBER TO VISIT LEIGH CREEK

Mr Bert Kelly, the Member for Wake-field will be in Leigh Creek again on Tuesday, 21st November, to meet Electors.

Last month he attended a Public Meeting in the Leigh Creek Theatre, where the future of television in remote areas was discussed with Mr Frank Brownless, the Engineer in Charge of Planning and Development from the Broadcasting Control Board, who travelled from Melbourne at Mr Kelly's request. Mr Kelly, a former Federal Minister, is a senior backbench Mem-Minister, is a senior backbench Mem ber and Chairman of the influential Public Works Committee. This Committee is charged with the responsibility to approving all Commonwealth Public Works in excess of \$750,000 and is representative of the three major Parties in both the Senate and the House of Representatives. In a Speech in Can-Representatives. In a Speech in Canberra last week Mr Kelly referred to the record number of Reports presented by the Committee in 1972. Mr Kelly said that there have been 78 reports and 180 meetings in the three years' work just completed by the Public Works Committee. The Committee has had referred to it and dealt with projects The Committee has had recosting \$407.8 million. Mr Kelly also paid a tribute to other members of the Committee when he referred to the fact that, although there had been many differences of opinion with re-

gard to some references, there had never been a division on Party Lines.

During his visit to Leigh Creek Mr Kelly hopes to meet as many people as possible during the day. He wi He will be accompanied on his visit by Senator Jessop.

In relation to Leigh Creek is the Min-ister aware that a third level airline would be able to provide a dailyRoll Call - River in Canada. service? Will he give serious consideration to recommending that this line be taken over so that the residents will be given a much more sat isfactory freight and passenger service?

Senator COTTON - I think it is a fair observation that in some of the internal flying in South Australia the load factors are not such as to make the operations all that profitable. In fact, some may be highly marginal Where a service has to be dropped because the available aircraft and






