





CRICKET MATCH - SUNDAY - 7th November


An INTERDEPARTMENTAL CRICKET MATCH has been organized between the Mechanical Branch and the Open-Cuts.

For the next month, keep an eye on the undersides of the leaves for small mildue spots developing, and if they become apparant, then spray immediately with Bordeaux. If you sprayed once or twice earlier, then the chances of infection are greatly reduced.

The vegetable garden should be in full production by now and continue to yield heavily for the next few months.

Tomatoes will need support very soon if you are growing the taller popular varieties. i.e. Gross Lisse or College Challenge. Good stout stakes should be used as mature tomatoes in full crop are very top heavy.

A quick guide to side dressing with fortilizers may be handy. Leafy crops like lots of Nitrogen. This can be supplied as Urea or Sulphate of Ammonia. Nitrogen produces lush green leaves. Ideal for lettuce and beet plants. Don't apply Nitrogen heavily to carrots or you get all tops and small roots. Strawberries are heavy feeders and again should not be given too much Nitrogen, or they produce large leafy plants and stop flowering. Fertilize every couple of weeks with Super Phosphate or Complete D. Strawberries are running now. For maximum and continued production, remove all runners except those needed for extra plants. This way the plants stay easier to manage and continue to flower for long periods.

CAKE TIN HINTS

"Season" new cake tins (unless of the nonstick variety) by putting them in a moderately hot oven; leave them to turn brown before using. They may smell a little in the process but cakes are less likely to stick in them afterwards. Don't wash tins after baking in them; just wipe round with kitchen paper. DON'T prepare tins AFTER mixture is ready or raising agent will start to work before cakes reach oven.


