"GREEN THUMB"

At this time of the year, lawns are growing quickly and should be cut regularly. They will benefit from a light dressing of fertiliser and should be given one or two good soakings a week rather than a light sprinkling.

ROSES and other flowering shrubs should have dead flowers removed and should be well mulched. Any dead branches on fruit or ornamental trees and shrubs should be removed.

VEGETABLES which can be planted now include - sweet corn, cucumbers, melons, beans, tomatoes and carrots. They grow rapidly in hot weather but need rich soil and regular watering.

ANNUAL FLOWERS which can still be
