

DID YOU KNOW? - THE HUMBLE AUSTRALIAN SAO BISCUIT is probably known to most people and has a very interesting origin.

While manager of his father's Biscuit factory in Sydney at the age of only 21, Authur Arnott went for a walk through St Leonards Park, Nth Sydney one Sunday afternoon where he heard a Salvation Army open-air meeting. He was taken home for tea by the Corps Treasurer and he became a Salvationist. So keen was he that he borrowed a Salvation Army red guernsey to wear home. Next morning he went out and bought a complete uniform to wear to the biscuit factory.

Colonel Arthur Arnott, up until his death in 1941, wrote many, many Salvation Army songs, some with intriguing titles like "I'd rather be a little thing going up, than a big thing coming

He left a legacy to Australians. As a tribute to the Salvation Army - a biscuit was named after the Army. Today, the SAO biscuit, which stands for SALVATION ARMY OFFICER, is eaten by thousands of Australians every day.






