



GREEN THUMB

Holiday times in the middle of summer poses problems in this climate regards keeping plants alive. It is advisable to give LAWNS a good heavy watering closest to your last day in town - this will carry any established lawn through the holiday period.

until WEDNESDAY 5/ 1/77.

***BREAD & MILK DELIVERIES will be irregular from XMAS DAY

If, however, you have recently established a lawn from seed, try to arrange for a mid holiday watering to be done by a neighbour. A couple of bad days can lead to the death of young lawns and the waste of many days of hard work.

POT PLANTS, especially soft types, should be well soaked by placing them in a tub of water, the level in the tub being the same as the soil level in the pot. Leave them for a couple of hours and then place in a selected shady and protected spot.

VEGETABLES & SHRUBS will need a good heavy watering prior to departure and heavy mulching will be of great value, serving to keep soil damp. Lawn clippings are excellent for this purpose. It is best to dry the clippings thoroughly first, then apply. This is especially so if your lawn has couch in it. Fresh clippings tend to pack and may keep the water out, so a weeks drying is advised before use.

NEWSLEIIEB

The sketch on the back of this sheet of the country surrounding Leigh Creek, shows the areas (shaded) looked at already as possible new town sites.

Some of these were considered unsuitable for various and obvious reasons, and there may still be other areas worthy of inspection.

The following points were looked at when considering all the areas:-

- (1) Ease of servicing with water and power.
- (2) Ability to support plant growth (natural trees, shrubs and gresses).
- (3) Proximity to the work location.
- (4) Prevailing winds.
- (5) Storm water catchment and dispersal.
- (6) Proximity to other services (rail, main road, airport etc).
- (7) Aesthetics views, surroundings, general outlook.
- (8) Obvious trouble areas salty ground, rocky outcroppings etc.

With due consideration to the above, the site adjacent to the Summit Tank (marked "A") and the site marked "B" are the most promising sites to date.

If there are other sites you think may be worth looking at, please let the Committee know as soon as possible, so an investigation can be carried out.


The Monarto Development Commission Project Team will conduct more comprehensive tests on the soils, wind movements etc., in the new year.


Once a definite recommendation has been made, the town planning will commence immediately.




