SWIMATHON 1972

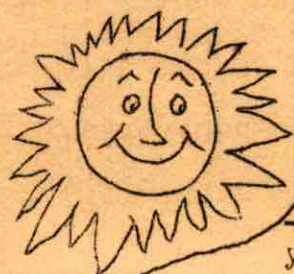

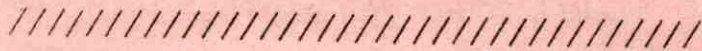
At this stage it looks as if Township have slipped a little and Northfield are stronger than before Christmas. Both teams, however, were weakened through absences.

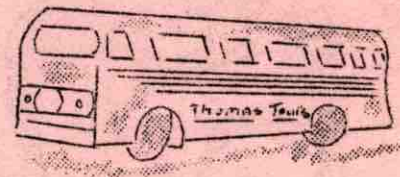
This Friday's clash between Town & Telford will be watched with interest as Telford have some new players in their side and they could really extend Town.
