



LEIGH CREEK **** FIRE BRIGADE

During December 1975 Mr Rowe of the South Australian Fire Brigade inspected (at our request) our fire equipment and methods. We are sure that you will be interested in the following extracts from his report.

"Fire Officer Beinke showed a professional approach his fire knowledge is sound and he instructs his men with a calm confident attitude."

"These men demonstrated an unhurried but efficient approach to their work and handled their equipment in a most capable manner."

"On sounding the siren (without any prior notice) 7 men and 2 police officers arrived at the fire station within 2 minutes. The men were mounted and mobile in 2 fire appliances before 3 minutes were up and had 2 lines of hose to work at the rubbish dump (nearly a mile) in 5 minutes. This is one of the best volunteer crew performances that I have witnessed."


The report contains some recommendations to improve our fire protection and equipment. The crew certainly deserve it on their performance, we are proud of them.

March is in some ways a betwixt month, as our summer lingers on, though officially autumn is upon us.

If you have some space in the vegetable garden you must now decide whether to plant one last crop of quick maturing summer growers like beans, zucchinis, sweet corn or cucumbers or leave the space for a few more weeks while you grow some seedling broccoli, cauliflower and brussell sprouts.

Weeds are doing extra well at the moment following the recent heavy rains. Make good use of lawn clips to mulch areas around shrubs and small trees and the vegetable garden.

Try to remove weeds before they seed, thus saving work in the future.

Weedicides are to be avoided as much as possible in the home garden. Several people have recently used a weedicide called Vorox and the results have been disasterous.

Mature stone fruit trees and many other ornamentals have been killed, and the affect lasts for well over a year.

My advise is DON'T TOUCH VOROX despite the grand stories about this wonder weedicide. It's far too dangerous. If couch grass is a problem, and we all know it is a BIG problem, a final try may be made with "DOWPON". This is most effective when sprayed on lush grass after a good watering. No guarantee can be given, but it is the best chance available and relatively safe.

However, in fairness to the non-carthorses we must look at the entire project. Pouring 40 cubic meters of concrete is not everybody's idea of spending an unpleasantly hot Sunday, nor is it necessary to involve EVERY member in EVERY part of the project.

There is a multitude of jobs to be tackled, including wood-work, steel construction, earth works, drainage, gardening and last but not least. fund-raising.
