Although the above is run by the local branch of the CWA (on a voluntary basis), it is open to ALL people of the town.

The hours are:-

7. pm - 7.30 pm / Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday, Saturday.

The fee to join is \$1.50 with books costing 5 cents or 10 cents each to take out for a period of 2 weeks. A fine of 2 cents per day is charged for books overdue. The average cost of one book to buy is \$5 - some cost us even more. New books are added about every 6 weeks.

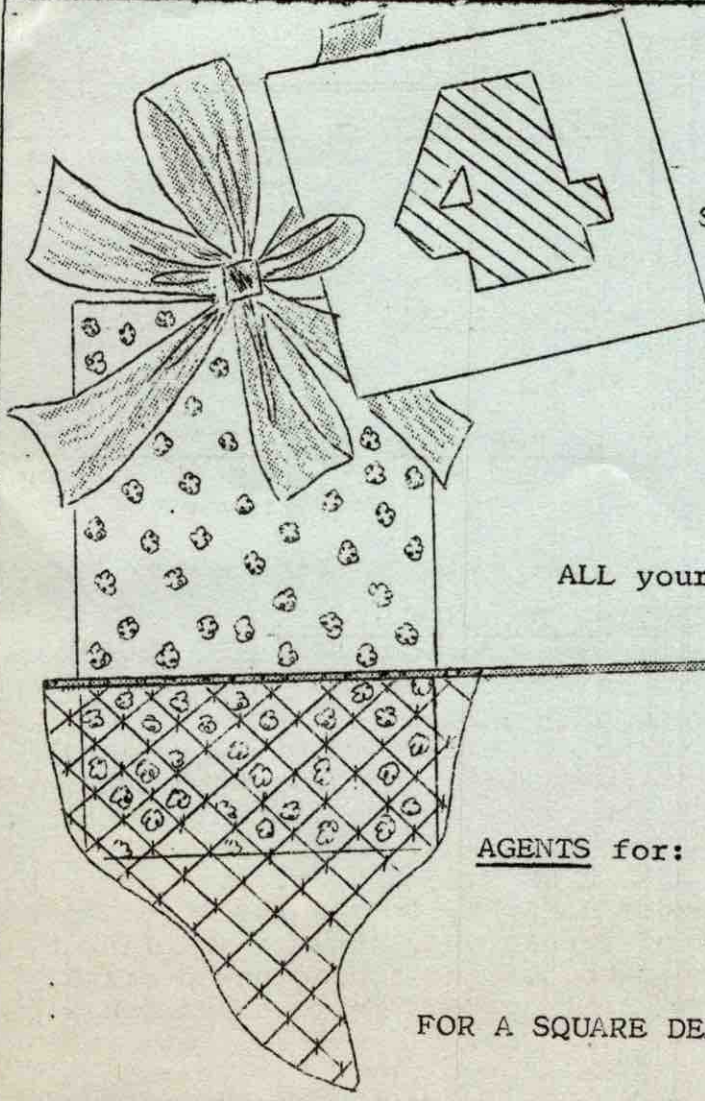

It is with extreme regret that we record the death of Mr SIGH WILTON - 31/ 1/74.

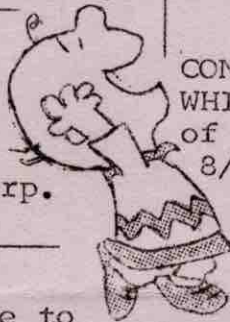
