Last Saturday the Leigh Creek Amateur Swimming Club held its annual carnival for the 1972/73 season. Over 300 nominations were received from 80 competitors.

Clubs competing were Leigh Creek, Peterborough, Quorn, Whyalla, Iron Knob and Norwood.

This was the largest carnival held in Leigh Creek for a number of years, but it was also the smoothest running competition we have yet held. This was no doubt due to the energetic work of all carnival officials and helpers on the day. We thank them for their willing help.

The RESULTS summarised in club order are:-

- IRON KNOB - One third placing.
- LEIGH CREEK - Three first, seven second and four third placings.
- NORWOOD - Two first, one second placing.
(Included was the "Far Northern Championship" -
(Miss Rosemary LONG).
- PETERBOROUGH - Ten first, four second and 5 third placings.
- QUORN - Two first, three second and six third placings.
- WHYALLA - One first and one second placing.

"Dear Green Thumb,

My Citrus trees have small spots on the foliage. What are they, and what should be done about them?

Mr 'B'

Answer: The trees have an infestation of one of the many scale insects. These suck sap from the trees and can weaken them. They are controlled by spraying the trees all over with a mixture of malathion and white oil in the warmer months of the year (now is ideal). These are available from the GARDEN SHED. Rates of application are on the containers.

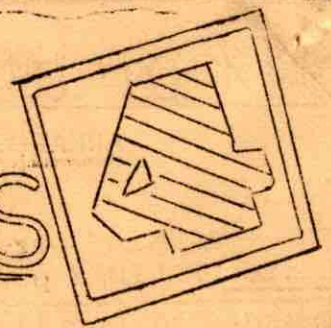
FEATURE TREE

"WHITE CEDAR" or Melia azedarach is a medium sized shade tree which has large, divided, graceful leaves and pale mauve scented flowers in summer, which are followed by clusters of yellow or orange coloured berries. These remain on the branches throughout winter. It is native to the rain forests in the Eastern States of Australia and Southern Asia, but strangely enough is hardy and drought resistant & thrives in hot dry areas. White Cedars would grow quickly in LC and when mature - app. 20 to 30' tall. (contact John ZWAR)
