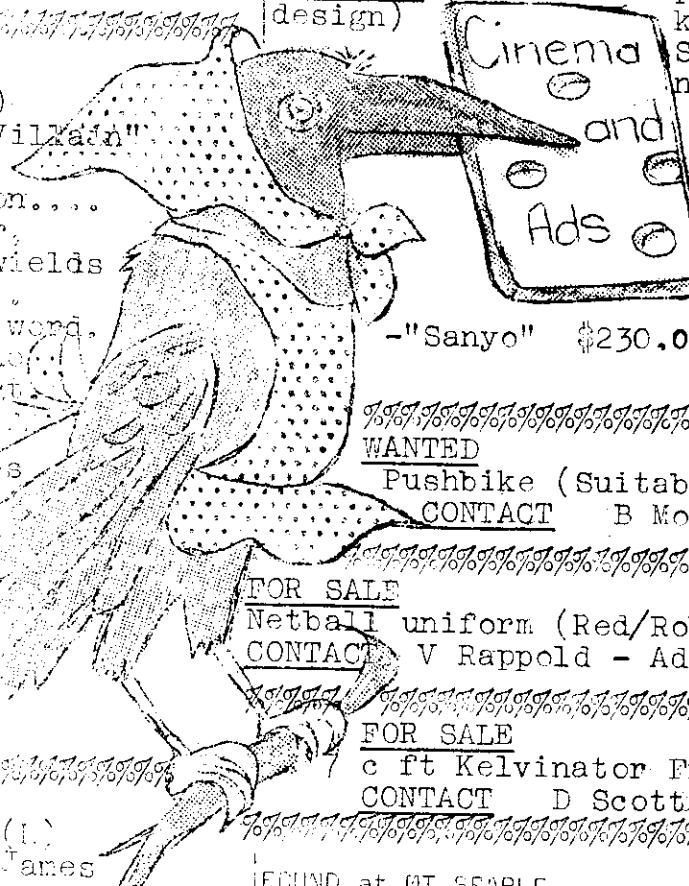

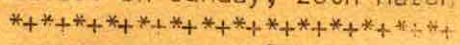

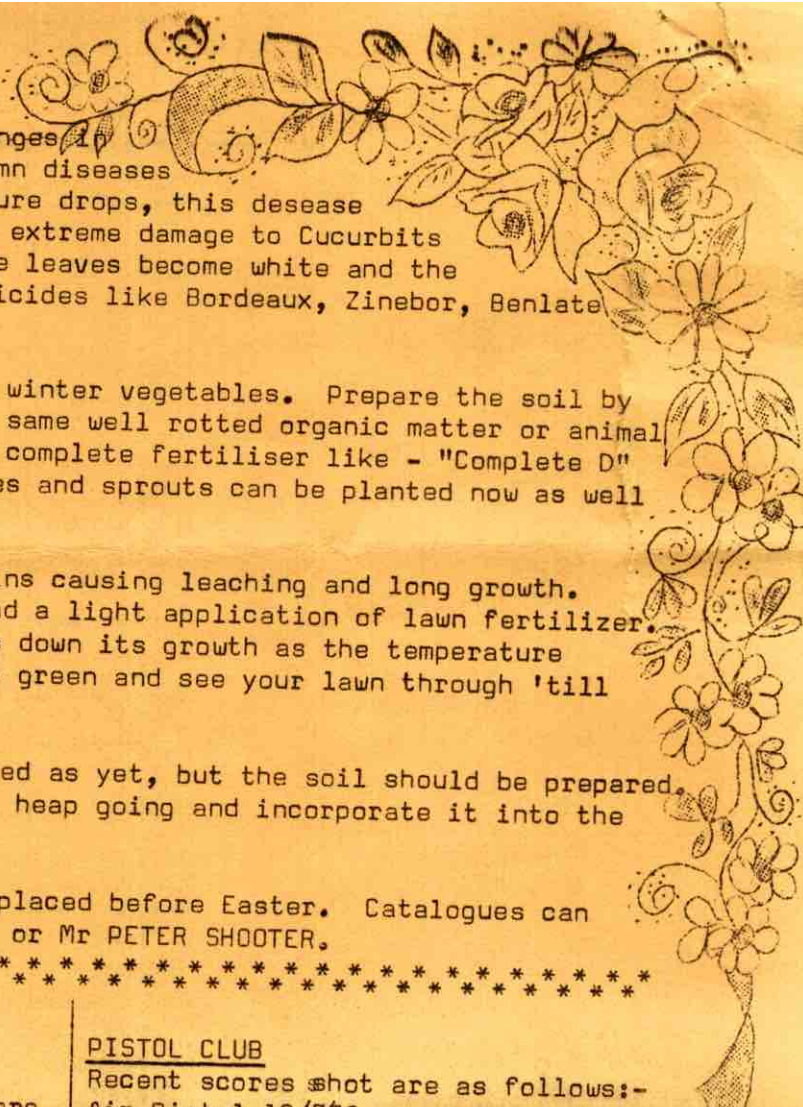

Green Thumb



Autumn is upon us and with it will come changes in the garden. One of the most startling autumn diseases is Powdery Mildew. As soon as the temperature drops, this disease strikes many of the summer crops and causes extreme damage to Cucurbits such as pumpkins, squash and zucchinis. The leaves become white and the plant appears to collapse. Spray with fungicides like Bordeaux, Zinebor, Benlate if this disease threatens your late crop.

Now is the time to get the garden ready for winter vegetables. Prepare the soil by digging and breaking down and incorporating some well rotted organic matter or animal manure if available. Dress the soil with a complete fertiliser like - "Complete D" or "Grow-Wel" organic. Cauliflower, cabbages and sprouts can be planted now as well as bush and climbing peas.

Lawns have suffered of late due to heavy rains causing leaching and long growth. Good response can be achieved from mowing and a light application of lawn fertilizer. Don't apply large amounts as the grass slows down its growth as the temperature drops. A light application will restore the green and see your lawn through 'till spring.

Spring flowers and bulbs should not be planted as yet, but the soil should be prepared. Bulbs love organic matter so get the compost heap going and incorporate it into the soil by late May.

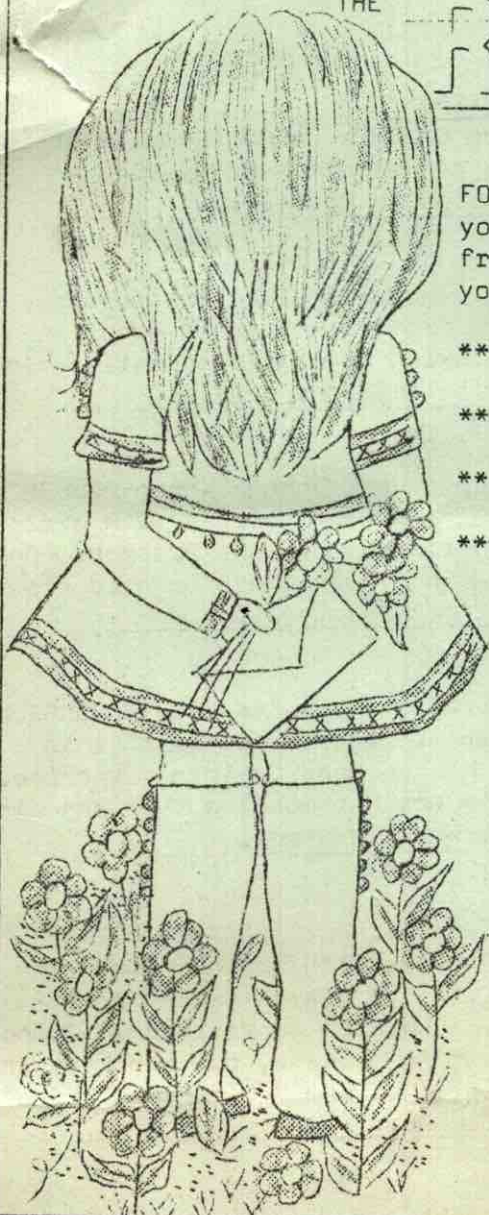
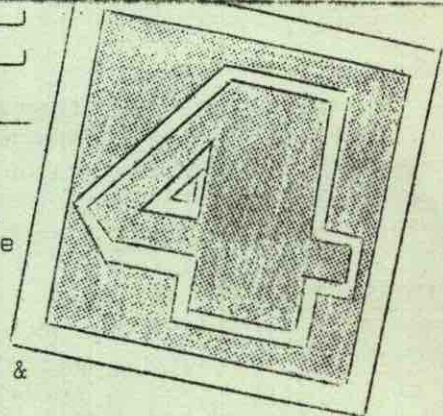

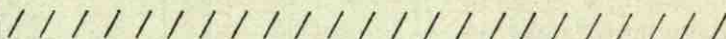
An extract from Foster Parents' letter is hereunder -

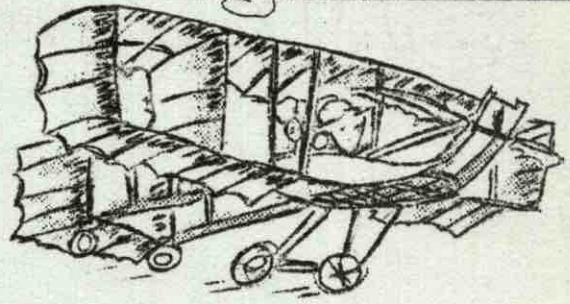

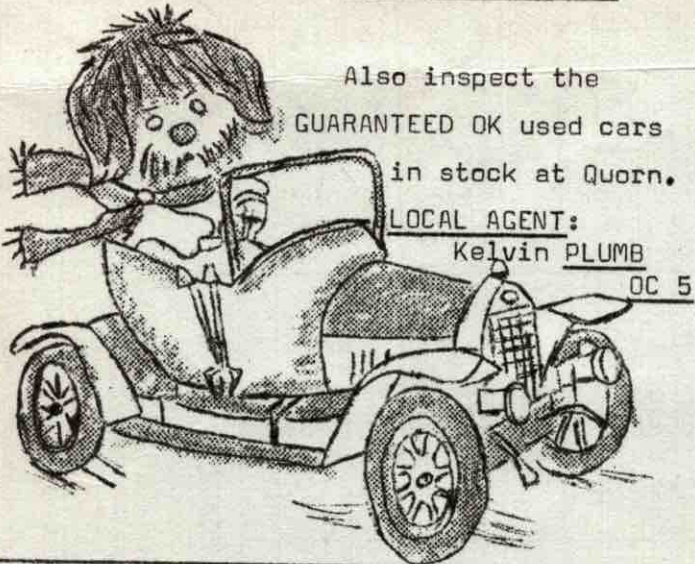

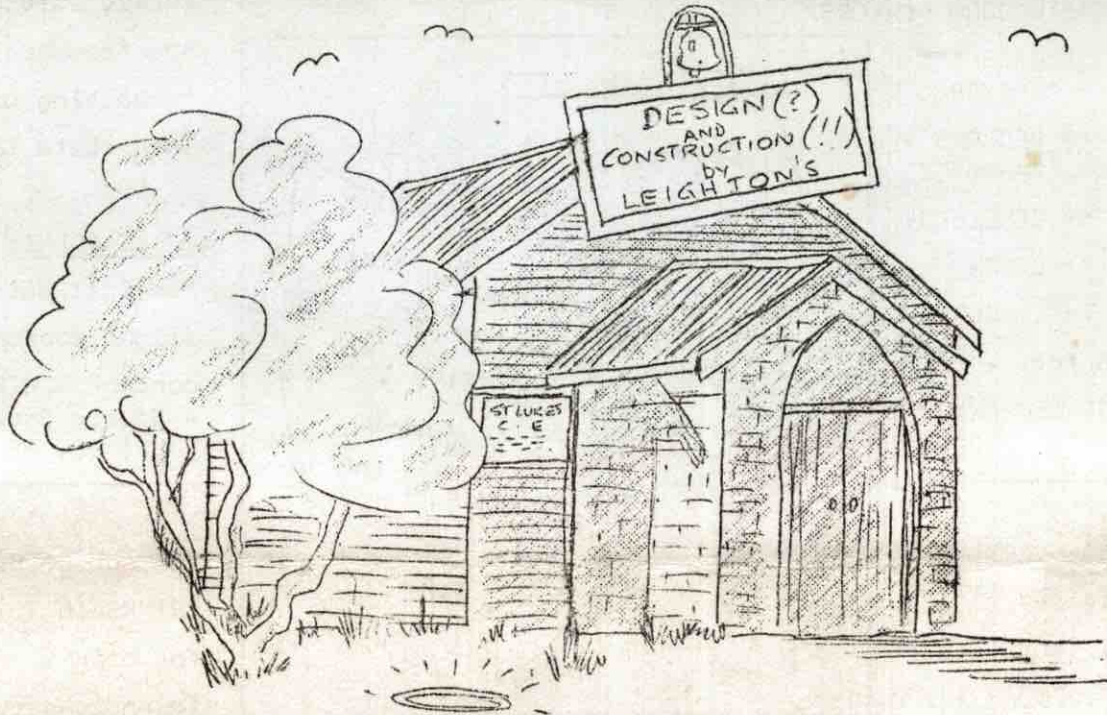
