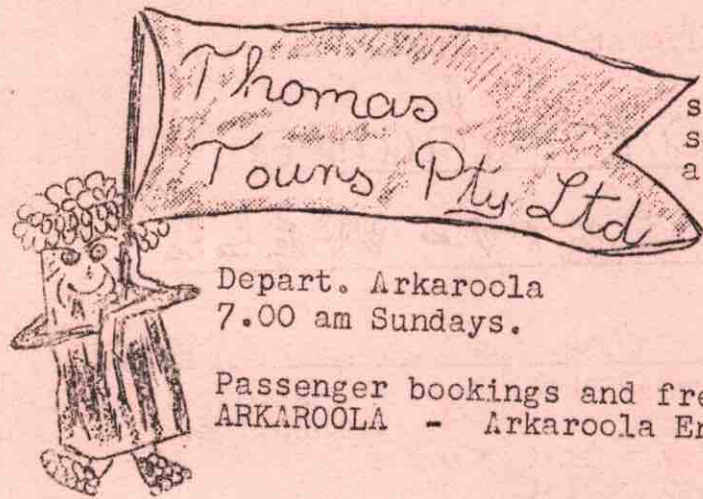

Medical

Immunization is a safe and effective way of protection against many diseases. A short explanation of the commonly used vaccines follows:

TRIPLE ANTIGEN - for immunization of children aged 3 months to 2 years against diphtheria, whooping cough and tetanus.

DIPHTHERIA--TETANUS - for immunization of children aged 2 years and above against diphtheria & tetanus.

TETANUS TOXOID - for immunization of adults and children over the age of 12 years against tetanus. (BOOSTER adviseable every 5 years).

SMALLPOX vaccine - best given at 16 months. Revaccination approximately every 3-5 years. This card is not valid for international travel.

POLIOMYELITIS vaccine - Sabin oral vaccine, may be started at 3 months of age. There is no upper age limit.

The above immunizations will now be given on a Saturday, once a month - the first on SATURDAY 8 APRIL 9 am to 5 pm. Future dates will be announced in 'Topics'.

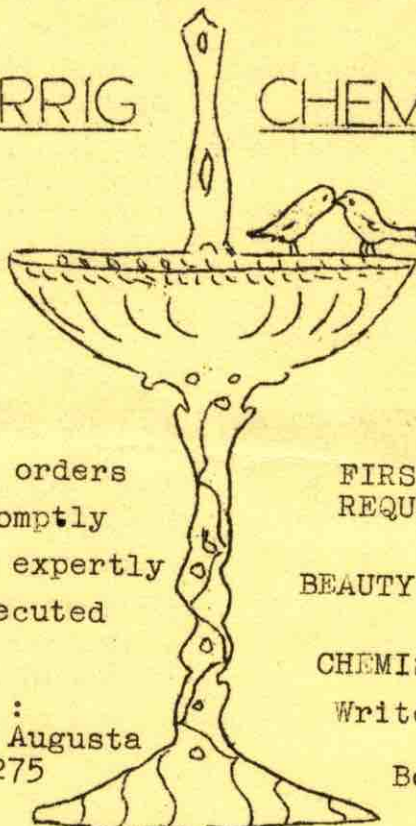

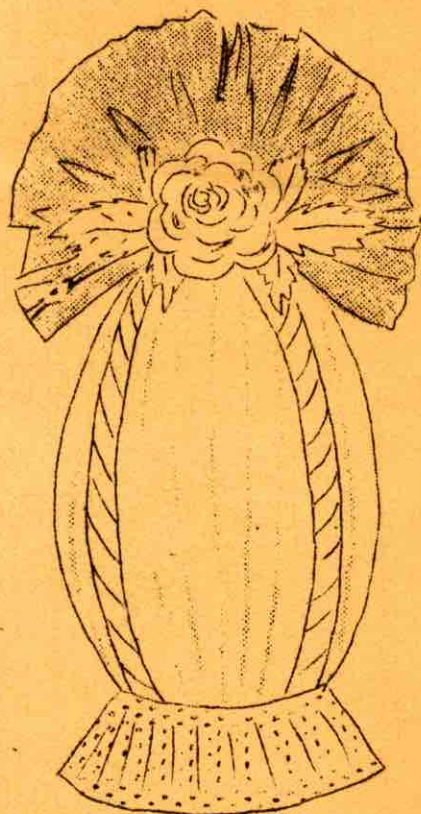
31 March to Monday 3 April inclusive the pool will be open from 1.30 pm to 5.30 pm.

Lost Property

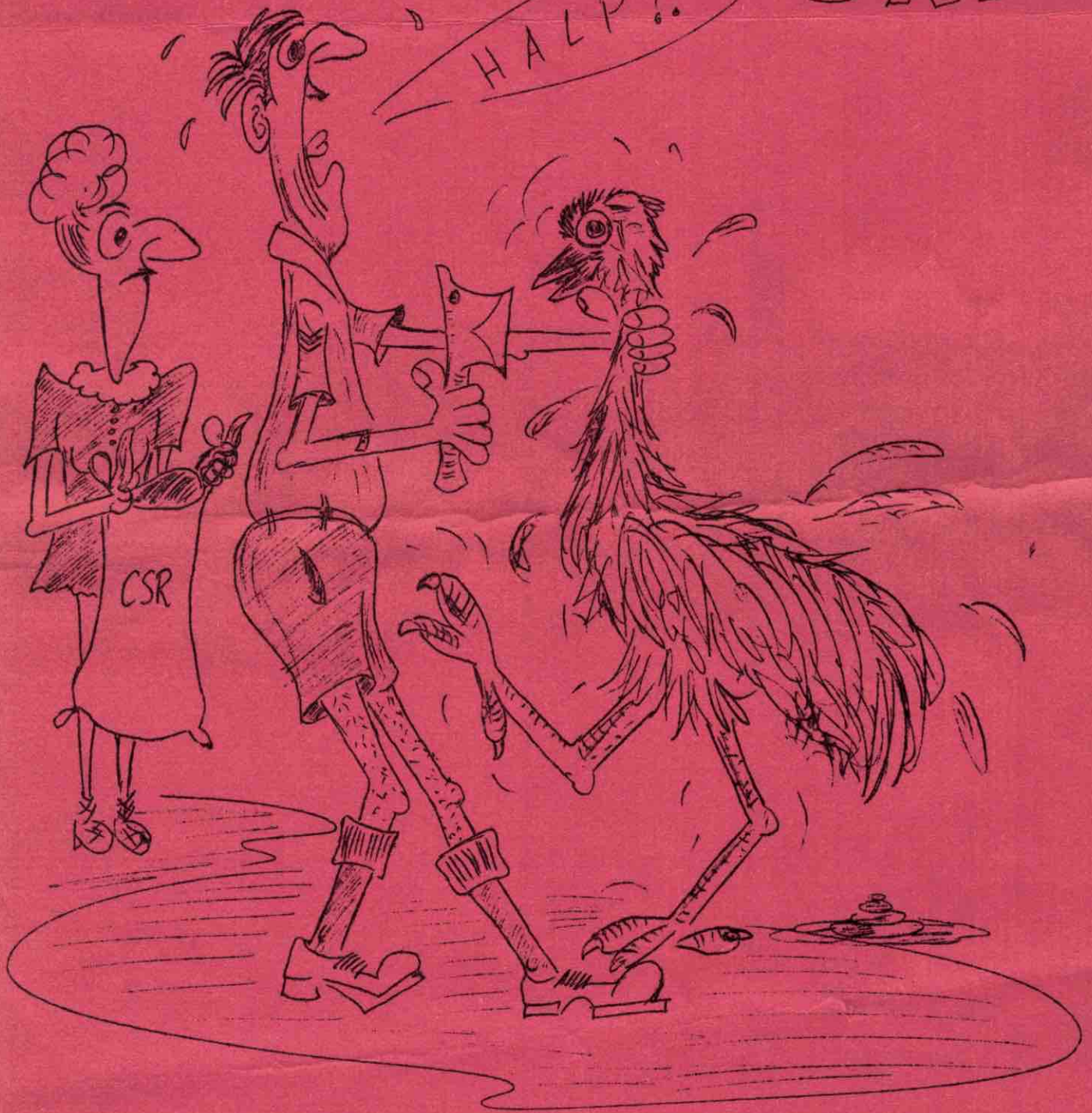
