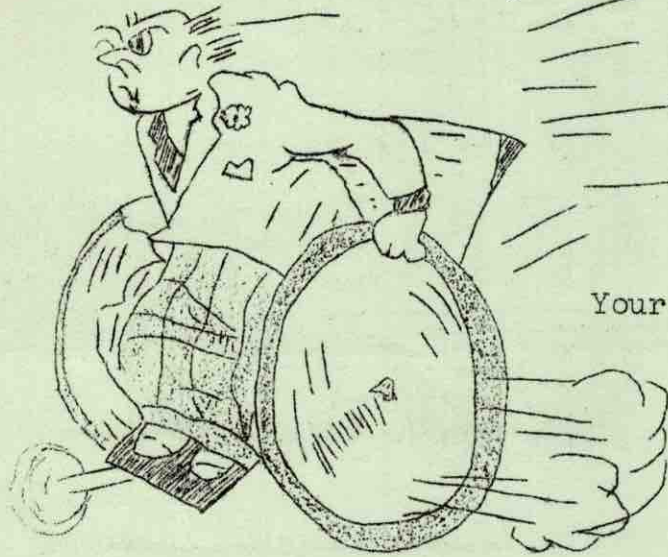

### NORTHERN STAR AIR TAXIS:-

We would welcome Capt. Jean-Henri ROUSSEAU, his wife and family to Leigh Creek. Full scale operations with the Air Taxis has commenced and we would like to pass on the following details:-

"The aircraft is a Cessna 172 and can carry three passengers and the pilot plus baggage at around 125 m.p.h. It has a high wing configuration with 2 passenger doors and is very easy to get in and out of. There are windows all around, (including the back), and the view is terrific. Casual rates are either 25 cents per airmile or the plane can be hired at \$32.00 per hour, this charge is in respect of engine time only and no other charges are made except where the aircraft is held by the client is responsible for reasonable overnight expenses incurred by the pilot.

The above rates are the maxima, but cheaper rates are available when a good utilisation is made of the aircraft, that is in excess of three hours per day. The aircraft is equipped and licensed for night flight but is not available for general charter at night. However, it is available for emergencies, i.e. ambulance functions etc. at night. The plane can be used from short, unprepared strips such as station strips, claypans and the like." We thank Capt. Rousseau for the above information and wish him the 'Best of Luck'.

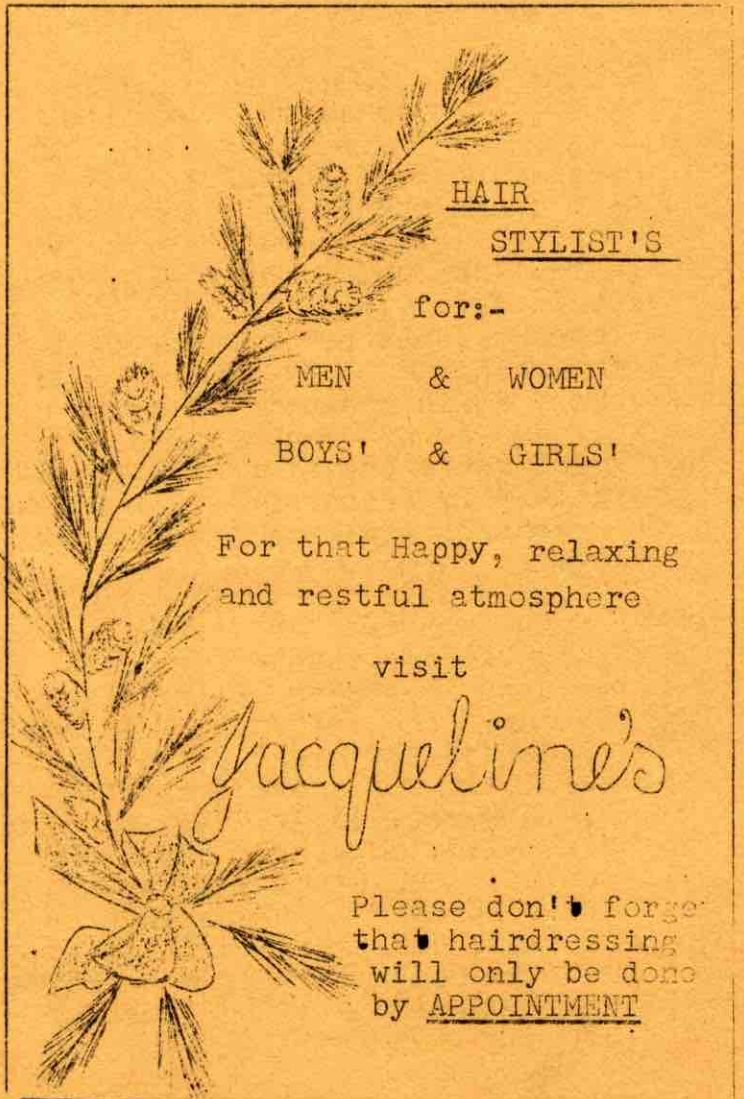

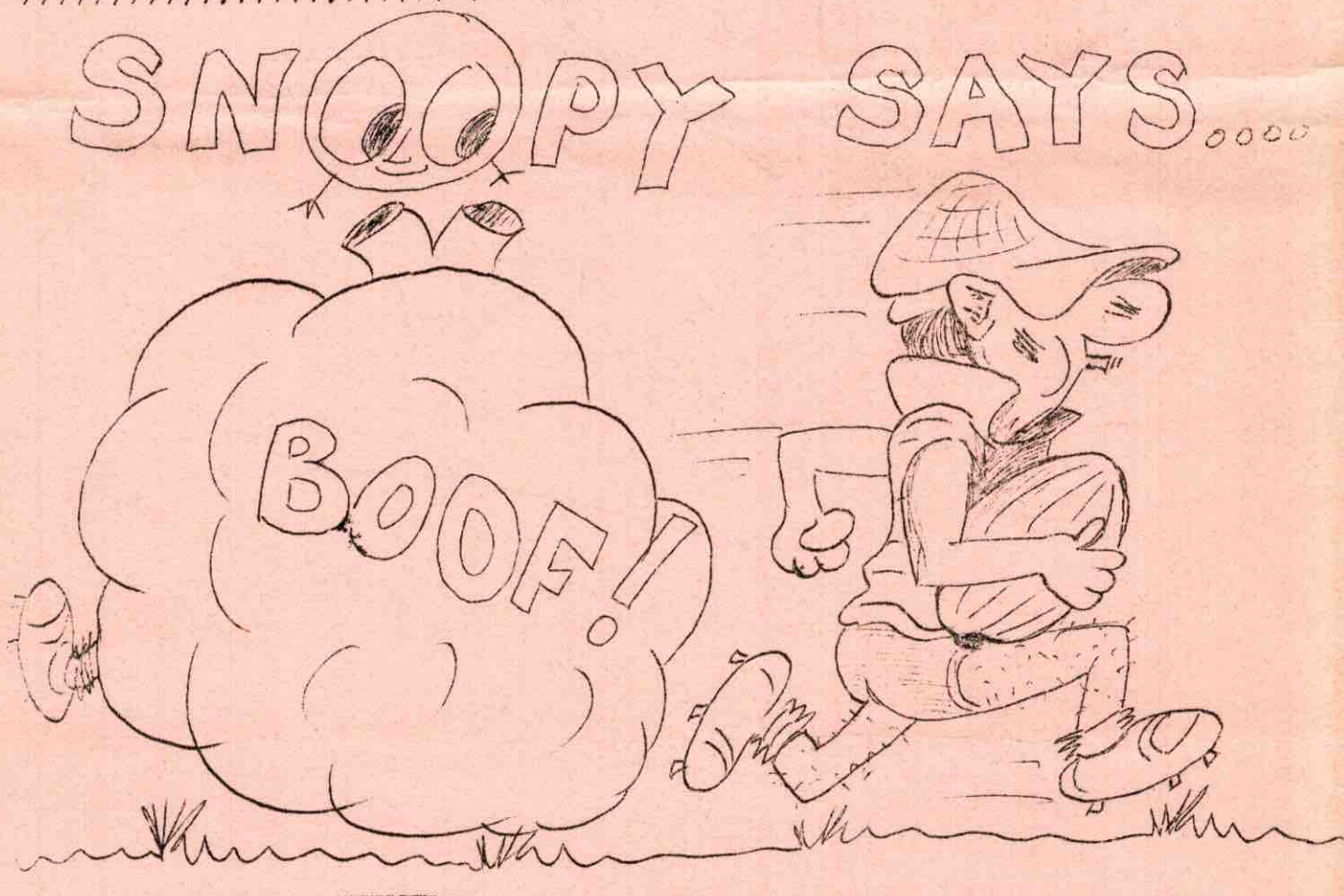

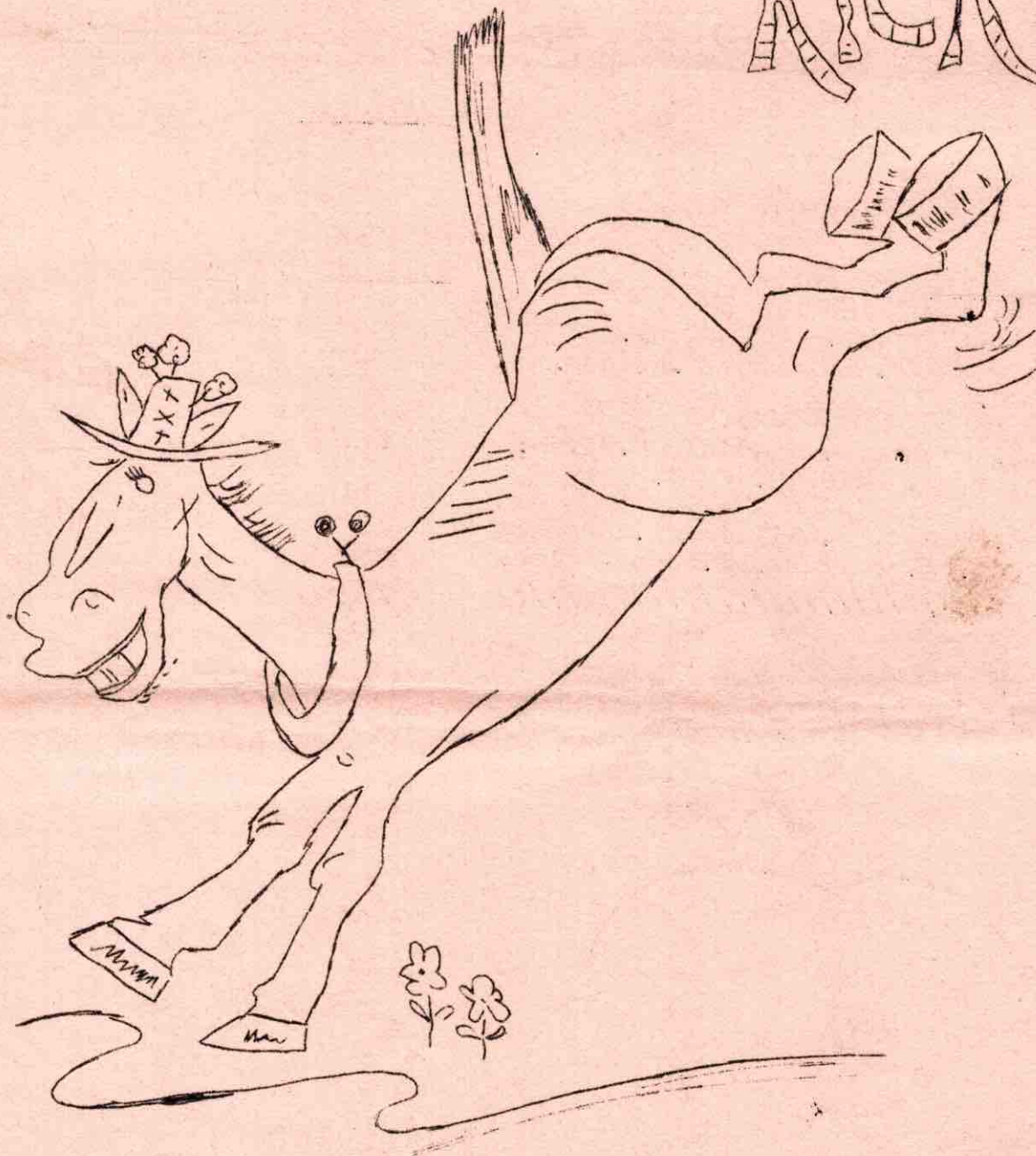
